Our extensive experience in training and education includes academic and non-academic settings, in both physical and online teaching situations. We have taught in the context of universities, public institutions, trade unions, and social and international organizations. The issues we have addressed in greatest depth are feminism and equality (including public policies), feminist economics, cooperation and (post)development, and care work.
